### Street Plan Is Not SmartCode Savvy

*The following letter was sent to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen this week.*

Dear Mayor and Aldermen,

Last week I attended the Planning Commission's workshop on the plans for the street work to be done under the CDBG funding for Downtown Revitalization. To say the least, I am extremely distressed at what is being proposed.

Over the past four years I have endeavored to learn all that I can about the new SmartCode zoning which our city has adopted. I am by no means an expert, but I have attended enough workshops, participated in enough seminars on street design, listened to enough mayors and governors of cities and states with viable downtown areas, and visited enough small towns with successful commercial centers to know that the

streets as currently drawn do not even begin to be compliant with the intents of the SmartCode.

The heart and soul of the New Urbanism approach to town design is to enhance the public realm through careful attention to street design in order to make our town a functional and inviting place for people to live and work on a day to day basis, as well as accommodate vehicular access. That is why there are more pages in the SmartCode ordinance dedicated to street layout than to any other subject.

The current proposals may to the untrained eye look good on paper, and may even look "cute" once built, but they in fact violate all of the design principals of our SmartCode.

The elimination of most on-street parking and the widening of traffic lanes, which increases speed, are extremely adverse to the development of a viable retail district.

Because all of this planning to date has been conducted without the city having conferred with our City Planner or Planning Commission, and the public has not been included in the process, we now find ourselves having to make some hard decisions under a tight deadline.

I realize that a lot of time and money have already been expended, and that we are at the eleventh hour in the plan-

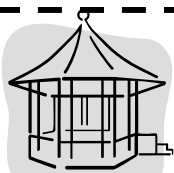
